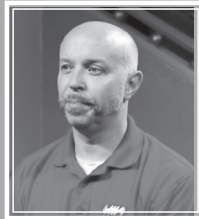

Our core values are community, healing, spirituality, recovery, peer empowerment, dignity, advocacy, voice, and solidarity

Our grassroots outreach extends City-wide. We are located in Milwaukee's food desert and Wisconsin's most resource-scarce zip code-53206. On 12/30/16 we purchased our permanent site at 2461 W. Center St. We have begun to convert the first floor into a mega-help center and hub of transformation and hope. Meanwhile we are impacting an average of 230 lives per week at two sites. MBHS delivers a proven successful, innovative pioneering grassroots model of an impactful community center. We address basic human needs and also provide a toolbox of what people need to advance in their life situations.

Our leadership stands in a 25-year track record of effectiveness. The extraordinary growth of MBHS demonstrates that our vision and our grassroots, personable, community-building approach is a driving force in creating extraordinary change within marginalized individuals and the attitudes of the larger community.
